Mario is sad because he misses Olivia, so he goes to Forever Forest to find a bench to sit on. While sitting on the bench he meets someone named Obscura, a post-goth woman whom he talks with and, while Mario slightly suspects of her, gets invited by her to a Tavern, where they make even more small talk with, unknowing of his drink being rooted as his spirit is unconsciously being taken prisoner while his body is used to take over the mushroom kingdom, laying darkness over it in the process. Before it reaches them Peach, Luigi, & Toadette take an emergency pipe that leads straight to Wario's castle. Wario says it won't be long until Obscura reaches his world, so he reveals a vase that leads to Subcon's world, which they take just as Wario attaches explosives to it which go off once they're all completely gone. Wario explains how he was once trapped into the Subcon as revenge by Team Syrup's leader Facunda's little sister, Obscura, who was then robbed of her riches before being left for dead by Wart. He then explained on how Obscura was planning on getting revenge on Wart (after accessing the same ^{dark} magic from the shadow queen to become a shadow master) before someone else got to Wart (be it Mario, Peach, Toad, or Luigi), leading her to a plan which required capturing Mario & defeating him one way or another, before getting to Wart. Obscura didn't know is that Facunda and Wario became a couple once they let bygones be bygones (due to Obscura spending so much time on a plan to capture Mario). Facunda explains how Obscura read about this dark magic, known as "the Roofie spell" where the caster traps his victim's soul into an illusion of an idealised existence while the victim's body is controlled by a dark entity that engulfs the world into the victim's illusions by sucking out their souls and encasing them while their bodies are used to accompany the victim's illusion. Facunda explains how it won't be long until Obscura reaches this realm yet states how it would be up to Mario to break the illusion. Facunda tells Peach how there is one other dark magic spell that could allow her to enter Mario's illusion without having her body lose her soul, but it's too risky (and time consuming) yet Peach accepts once Facunda lets her upon having the former notice how Peach showed concern and explains why Mario allowed himself to fall into all of this to begin with. Once Obscura makes it to Subcon's world Wario tries to stall her, but Obscura defeats him with her hands tied behind her back and imprisons his soul inside of Mario's illusion. Peach tries contacting Wario on the phone, but it is instead Obscura who

advises Peach to look over the horizon. To her dismay the entirety of the Subcon world is starting to fade into a nightlike storm. Facunda says she still needs more time with the dark magic spell, so Wart resolves this and takes a box out labelled "Emergency only". He opens it to reveal a Warp whistle, which he hands to Facunda, advising Peach to hold Facunda's hand in the process. Wart gives Facunda a goodbye kiss before leaving his abode and donning an old cape as they blow the whistle and are transported out of Subcon. Peach and Facunda are transported to the star Summit, where Peach calls upon Twink (by singing a poem), who agrees to call upon the star spirits for support, before Peach and Facunda are transported to the Delfino first. Obscura approaches Wart, whom they fight at first. Just as she cherishes her vengeance upon defeating him, he asks if she'd like to split a beet. Obscura grants him this, but then she is shocked to realize the obvious as she watches him munch on half a beet: Wart hates vegetables. Wart then says he never could master method acting yet wasn't too bad at fooling her. He then snaps his fingers to morph into his true identity: Bowser. Obscura aggressively asks him where Peach and Facunda went, but he

faints from the battle, impulsing her to read
his mind. It shows Peach and Facunda are in
Isle Delfino. Facunda then steals Bowser's floating
down car (which was located in the basement of
the building upon reading his mind) to travel towards
Isle Delfino. Upon reaching the Isle Obscura sees
where Peach and Facunda are located. Obscura
approaches them excitedly at first, but upon further
close inspection she says "Oh beloved sister... and
Princess Toadstool. I can see you're not accompanied
by Toadsworth for once." To which she complies
"But at least Baby Bowser hasn't kidnapped you
for once" To which she still complies "And hey,
now that you're here I heard the legendary
sandbird is a must for tourists. He's made of...
sand-spheres, is he not, sis?" Facunda loses face
and says he's actually made of sand-blocks,
to which Peach facepalms herself. "Funny" says
Obscura before levitating them both in a dark
static "Neither you nor Peach ever saw it". The
figures morph back to their real forms: Kammy
Koopas and Kammy Koopa, whom she reads the minds
of before absorbing their spirits. She then reads
their minds to see Peach and Facunda are
really in the Star Summit. Obscura confronts
Facunda and Peach, with the two sisters having a
harsh face off, Star Spirits included, but Obscura and
dark Mario manage to defeat them (although Facunda lets

Obscura know as a warning that she doesn't know Peach as well as she thinks before her spirit is fully absorbed. Obscura then approaches Peach to absorb her spirit, but Peach willingly surrenders, in where Obscura removes her spirit anyway before saying "Suit yourself" as she places her spirit back into her body and commands her to touch dark Mario so as to enter his idealised reality. Once inside Peach talks to Mario long enough before it happens: It is revealed that Facunda sacrificed her spirit somehow to let Peach inhabit Facunda's body while Olivia inhabited Peach's body, who temporarily shapeshifted into Peach, particularly thanks to Kiddy and Kamek (Koopa, to fool Obscura. Obscura tries convincing Mario that they're evil doppelgangers (Creeping as only HE can break the illusion) but Mario believes Olivia and hits Obscura with his hammer. This causes the illusion to fall apart and the darkness from their surroundings to vanish. Obscura tries fighting, but is instantly defeated by Peach, Mario, Twink, the 7 star spirits & Facunda being inhabited by Olivia, which causes her to vanish. After this happens Facunda's body becomes transparent as Olivia separates them. It ends with Olivia, Facunda and Peach telling Mario that even though they're not meant to be together it doesn't mean he has to be alone, with just Mario and Peach left as the latter places a hand on the former's shoulder and smiles.

Note: The fantasy in which Mario and Obscura partake in is essentially a clichéd 10s anime, from Mario waking up in a traditional house (with no doorknobs) to Obscura inviting Mario to her job as a Mushroom Kingdom history teacher (with the classroom looking like any other, apart from the Toads dressed in school attire) to even Mario and Obscura going to the beach with their friends (once they've been assimilated) and it ends with a cityscape (saturated with the loud noise of cicadas) or hill abundant countryside, beginning to crumble as a black hole in the sky (akin to the one from the penultimate episode of the Garlic Jr. saga from DBZ albeit with 90% more (G) appears after Peach and Olivia tell Mario the truth about Obscura's world.
